(started will be woolies/ advanced and open will be hair sheep/hair sheep crosses)

**Ducks:** 5 head                    12 Max Runs (Fri)      20 Maximum Runs (Sat and Sun)

Cattle: \$30.00 Pre-Entry            \$35.00 Day of Show

Sheep: \$25.00 Pre-Entry            \$30.00 Day of Show

Ducks: \$20.00 Pre-Entry            \$25.00 Day of Show

Open Working Junior: Same as Above

Working Junior Handler: \$8.00 Pre-entry            \$10.00 Day of Show

***All pre-entries must be postmarked on or after May 15, 2006 through June 9, 2006.***

***No entries will be accepted with a postmark before May 15, 2006.***
