

Tips for taking and sending photos:

Taking Your Pictures:

Use natural light, go outside or be near a window. Try not to use a flash.

Get at the same level as your pet.

Keep your composition tight. Focus on your subject.

Be patient and take a lot of shots to increase your chances of getting a keeper.

Watch the background. Dark backgrounds are best for light subjects and visa versa. Make sure it is not too busy.

Camera Settings:

Make sure your camera is set correctly. Least compression and highest resolution. Most digital cameras have this type of setting (Super Fine, Super High Quality, etc depending on your camera). This is the most common problem I have when people send photos.
