## SHEEP FARM TRIAL

20 minute with a warning at 10 minutes and 3 minutes  
Tie is broken by fetch than sort. Set out dog will be used as needed.

1. Pen Work (5 pts) Take 5 sheep from holding pen 1 and put into Pen A.
2. Pen Work (5pts) Take 5 sheep from holding pen 2 and also put into Pen A. Handler and dog exit to Arena B.
3. Pen Work (10pts) Take the 10 sheep out of Pen A and put into Arena B.
4. Gather (20pts) Handler and dog go to cone 1 for gather. Advanced handler must stay at cone until gather is complete. Open handler must leave dog at cone 1 but can go half way to cone 2 before sending dog. Gather sheep around cone 1 than gather/ or drive back to Pen A and put them back into Pen A. Handler and dog exit.
5. Pen Work (5pts) Take sheep from west side of Pen A and put into chute area.
6. Chute Work (20pts) Load the 10 sheep into chute. Advanced handlers must stay behind handlers line ( 10ft from chute) until sheep are loaded than they can move to close end gate. Open handlers has no restrictions. Ribbon 5 sheep while in the chute. Take sheep from chute and exhaust into Arena C.
7. Trailer load (20pts) Load sheep into trailer and close gate. Open handler will have a wing panel to help load. Advanced handlers will load without wing panel. Exhaust sheep from trailer into Arena C.
8. Hold in designated area. (20pts) Take sheep and hold in designated area until judge tells you it is a "HOLD" Return sheep to Pen A.
9. Sort (25pts) From Pen A sort 5 marked (ribbon) sheep into holding Pen 1. Sort 5 remaining sheep into holding Pen 2.

End of run.

Holding Pens 1 & 2: 10ft x 8ft.

Pen A: 20ft x 20ft

Arena B: 150ft x 250ft

Chute area: 60ft x 80ft

Chute: 16ft long

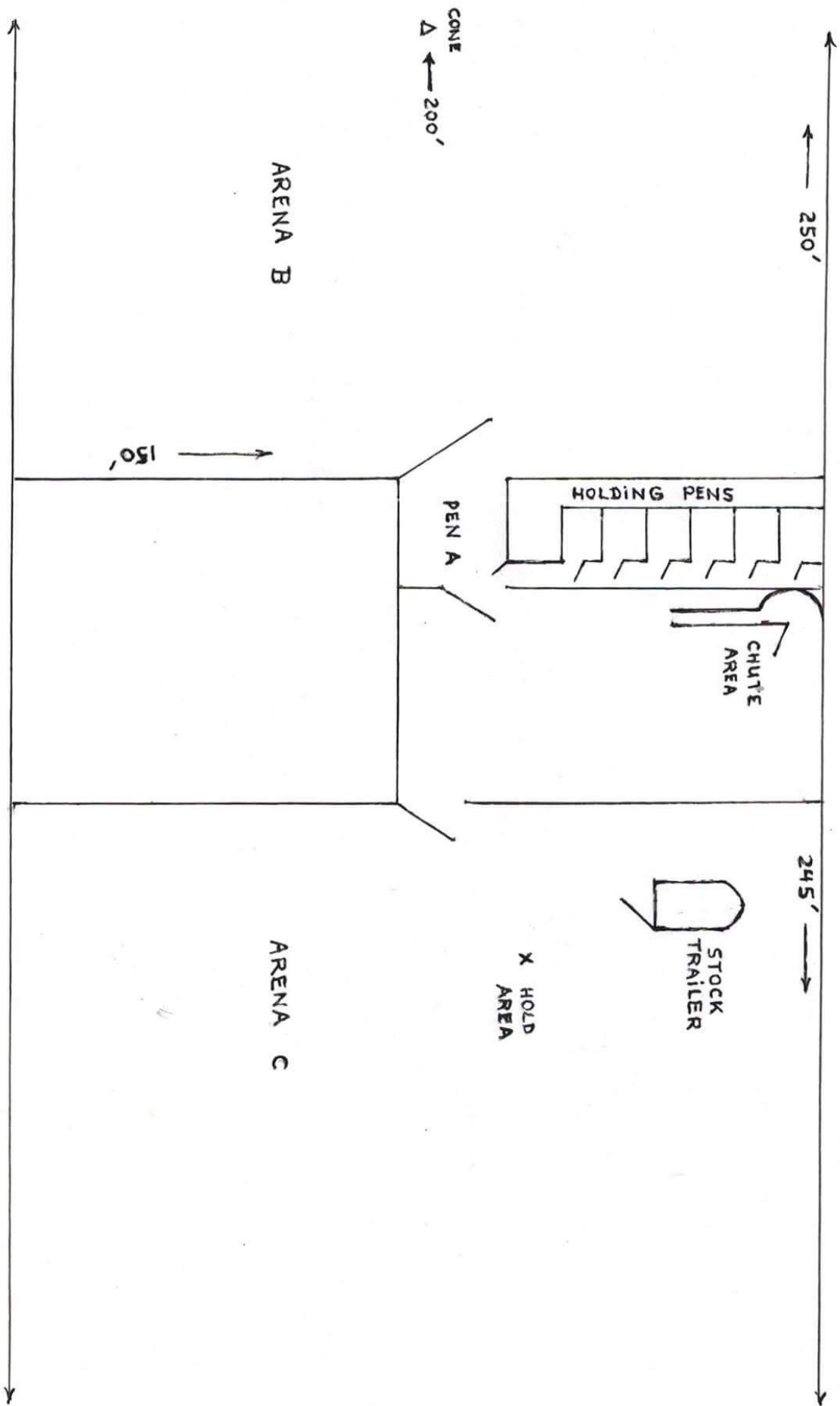
Gather: 150ft

Arena (Pen) C: 150ft x 245ft

Trailer: 16ft

Hold area: 25ft circle

# UMASC FARM TRIAL SHEEP



## DUCK FARM TRIAL

17 minute limit with a 3 minute warning.

Tie broken by fetch than sort.

No set out dog used.

1. Pen Work (5pts) Take 5 ducks from holding Pen 1 and put into Pen A.
2. Pen work (5pts) Take 5 ducks out of holding Pen 2 and also put them into Pen A. Handler and dog exit to Arena B.
3. Pen work ( 10pts) Take the 10 ducks from Pen A and put into Arena C.
4. Gather (20pts) Handler and dog go to cone 1 for gather. Advanced handlers must stay at cone. Open Handlers must leave dog at cone 1 and may go half way to cone 2 before sending dog on gather. Gather ducks to cone 1.
5. Hold ( 20pts) Take ducks to designated HOLD area. Hold until judge tells you it is a HOLD.
6. Chute (20pts) Load ducks into chute. Advanced handlers must stay behind handlers line until ducks are loaded into chute than they can cross the line to close end gate. ( Handlers line 10ft from chute) Open handlers have no restrictions. While in chute spray ducks for parasites. Release ducks into Pen B.
7. Pen Work (5pts) Remove ducks from Pen B and put into Arena C.
8. Wagon/Trailer Load (20pts) Load ducks onto wagon. Advanced handlers must stay behind handlers line until wagon is loaded than they may cross line to close gate. ( Handlers line 10ft from wagon) Ramp to wagon has a wing on to load with. Take wagon and transport ducks to Pen A. Unload ducks and put into Pen A.
9. Sort (25pts) From Pen A sort off the 5 marked ducks and put into holding Pen 1. Put remaining 5 ducks into holding Pen 2.

End of run.

Holding Pen: 1 & 2: 5ft x 5ft

Pen A: 12ft x 12ft

Arena C: 100ft x 100ft

Chute: 10ft

Pen B: 12ft x 12ft

Hold area: 10ft circle
