Entry Information:

Eligibility:

ASCA agility trials are open to ALL breeds, including mixes. Your dog does NOT have to be registered with ASCA to enter ASCA agility trials. However, to earn titles, you must have a tracking number or an ASCA Australian Shepherd registration. A tracking number application is included in this premium.

Late/Date of Trial (DOT) Entries:

Any entry postmarked after October 8, 2011, will be considered a DOT entry and be charged the higher class entry fee. We will accept these entries after October 8 until 7:15am on each trial day, up to 350 runs per day. **DOT fees:** \$15/class or a DOT Daily Pkg of \$60 for five classes/same day.

Height Cards & Measurements:

Only dogs measuring $18^{\prime\prime}$ or under at the shoulder need to be measured or submit a height card with their entry. We will accept height cards from AKC or NADAC.

Levels:

Exhibitors may, at their discretion, enter at a level higher than they have titled. If they are registered to receive titles, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles.

Move-Ups:

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted. Move-ups for Saturday must be received by Monday, October 10, 2011. Sunday move-ups must be received by the end of the trial on Saturday.

Equipment:

Slatted A-frame & dogwalk and slatless teeter will be used. Jumps (including double), tunnels, weave poles (24-inch spacing) and displaceable tire may be used at the judge's discretion.

Prizes and Awards:

Qualifying and 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each class. Placements will be combined for 20+ and 24" dogs in all divisions.

HIT Rosettes Requirements:

Dogs must be entered in all runs both days to be eligible for HIT awards. HIT calculations are based on scores from Jumpers/Gamblers/Regular. HIT Level determined as level the dog was entered in Regular class. HIT Aussie and HIT Other Breed will be based on the total Q points for that dog, regardless of level(s). Aussies must have an ASCA reg. number to qualify for the Aussie HIT. Points for HIT are calculated as follows: Elite Q - 7 pts, Open Q - 6 pts, Novice Q - 5 pts. Each faulted Q run in Regular shall be given one-half the value of the equivalent level HITQ points. In the event of a tie, dog with the fastest combined YPS will be the winner.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available for viewing or download at: www.asca.org.
- ASCA, UMASC and On The Run Canine Center will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when using the warm up area or in the agility ring.
- Any ASCA members currently not in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed entry into the trial. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of fees will be paid.
- No refunds will be granted after the closing date. Refunds, less a \$25
 administration fee, will be granted for bitches in season and injured dogs, if
 the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's letter and provided to the
 trial secretary no later than noon on Sunday.
- FEO (For Exhibition Only) We will accept FEO entries. Dogs entering FEO must be a minimum of 15-months of age. FEO entries may jump at a lower height, but are not eligible for any prizes or awards. Any dog under 18-months must jump at a lower height. This is a non-qualifying division.



Dogs showing threatening behavior will be subject to either disqualification or excusal, per the ASCA Dog Bite Policy. All UMASC investigations and appropriate forms will be forwarded on to the ASCA Business office. Dogs excused or disqualified under said policy will be excused from the remainder of the event and asked to leave, without refunds of entry fees.

Upper Midwest Australian Shepherd Club Genetic Health Clinic for HSF4 (Hereditary Cataract) and U of MN Epilepsy Study

Upper Midwest Australian Shepherd Club will be offering a hereditary cataract test (cheek swab) and a blood draw for a U of MN Epilepsy Study at the October 15th and 16th agility trial at On the Run in Ham Lake.

Hereditary Cataract Test: The cataract DNA test (via cheek swab) will identify if your Aussie carries a mutation of the HSF4 gene which is responsible for the Hereditary Cataract in Australian Shepherds. Only one parent needs to carry the mutation for hereditary cataracts to be passed on to its offspring. The HSF4 gene mutation can potentially cause cataracts that might eventually cause the dog to go blind. The test would be very important for any Aussie you may be planning to breed. It will also give valuable information on the health and well being of our Aussies that aren't being used for breeding. The cost of the test is \$45.00/dog.

Right now, we just need to know how many test kits to order. If you are interested in testing your Aussie, please send an email to Carrie Van Horn - mooncrest5@msn.com. Please put in the subject line:

"UMASC Hereditary Cataract Test" so she can easily identify that you would like to order a test kit. She will need to know how many kits you would like to order. If you can't make it to On the Run, we can either try to get you a kit and you can test your dog yourself or Carrie has offered to hold a makeup session at her home in East St Paul at a time convenient to her and most of the participants. If you would like to have your Aussie tested please let Carrie know by October 7th that you would like to participate and how many tests you need.

Epilepsy Study Blood Draw: The University of Minnesota is conducting studies into the genetic basis of Idiopathic Epilepsy (IE) in the Australian Shepherd breed. They are hoping to be able to find genetic mutation(s) that are associated with IE to develop a screening test for use in diagnosis of IE and in breeding decisions. They are looking for Australian Shepherds with epilepsy, as well as older unaffected dogs for these genetic studies. To participate, you will need to complete a consent form, a short questionnaire, and have a small blood sample collected for each dog. This study has been funded by the Canine Health Foundation and Toby's Foundation.

The U of M would like blood samples from 1) any dog who has had seizures, 2) full siblings of affected dogs (and other close relatives) that are at least 5 years of age but who have not had seizures or 3) Aussies who are at least 8 years of age and who have never had a seizure - and are not known to have close relatives with seizures . The study can take dogs that do not have a pedigree and/or weren't registered if you are sure they are pure bred.

If you have a dog that meets one of the above qualifications and you would like to contribute a blood sample to the research project, we will be doing blood draws at the at the October 15th and 16th agility trial at On the Run in Ham Lake. We will also deliver the samples and paperwork to the U of M. There will be no cost for the blood draw or research submission.

If you are interested in donating a blood sample, please send an email to Carrie Van Horn - mooncrest5@msn.com so she knows how many collection tubes will be needed . **Please put in the subject line: "U of M Epilepsy Study".** Carrie will then provide you with the necessary paper work which requests information on your dog's pedigree and other health screenings that have been done. This information must be submitted at the time of the blood draw so it should be completed ahead of time.

ASCA MEMBERSHIP AND TRACKING NUMBER FORM

It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.
