Entry Information:

Eligibility:

ASCA agility trials are open to ALL breeds, including mixes. Your dog does NOT have to be registered with ASCA to enter ASCA agility trials. However, to earn titles, you must have a tracking number or an ASCA Australian Shepherd registration. A tracking number application is included in this premium.

Date of Trial (DOT) Entries:

Any entry postmarked after April 23, 2011, will be considered a Day of Trial entry and be charged the higher class entry fee. We will accept these entries after April 23 until 7:15am on each trial day, up to 350 runs per day. **DOT fees: \$15/class or a DOT Daily Pkg of \$72 for six classes/same day.**

Height Cards & Measurements:

Only dogs measuring 18" or under at the shoulder need to be measured or submit a height card with their entry. We will accept height cards from AKC or NADAC.

Levels:

Exhibitors may, at their discretion, enter at a level higher than they have titled. If they are registered to receive titles, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles.

Move-Ups:

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted. Move-ups for Saturday must be received by Monday, May 2, 2011. Sunday move-ups must be received by the end of the trial on Saturday.

Equipment:

Slatted A-frame & dogwalk and slatless teeter will be used. Jumps (including double), tunnels, chute, weave poles and non-displaceable tire may be used at the judge's discretion.

Prizes and Awards:

Qualifying and 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each class. Placements will be combined for 20+ and 24" dogs in all divisions.

HIT Rosettes Requirements:

Dogs must be entered in all runs both days to be eligible for HIT awards. HIT calculations are based on scores from Jumpers/Gamblers/Regular. HIT Level determined as level the dog was entered in Regular class. HIT Aussie and HIT Other Breed will be based on the total Q points for that dog, regardless of level(s). Aussies must have an ASCA reg. number to qualify for the Aussie HIT. Points for HIT are calculated as follows: Elite Q - 7 pts, Open Q - 6 pts, Novice Q - 5 pts. Each faulted Q run in Regular shall be given one-half the value of the equivalent level HITQ points. In the event of a tie, dog with the fastest combined YPS will be the winner.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available for viewing or download at: www.asca.org.

- ASCA, UMASC and Arrowhead Dog Training Academy (ADTA) will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm up area or in the agility ring.
- Any ASCA members currently not in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed entry into the trial. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of fees will be paid.
- No refunds will be granted after the closing date. Refunds, less a \$25 administration fee, will be granted for bitches in season and injured dogs, if the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's letter and provided to the trial secretary no later than noon on Sunday.
- FEO (For Exhibition Only)** – We will accept FEO entries. Dogs entering FEO must be a minimum of 15 months of age. FEO entries may jump at a lower height but are not eligible for any prizes or awards. Any dog under 18 months must jump at a lower height. This is a non-qualifying division.
- Dogs showing threatening behavior will be subject to either disqualification or excusal, per the **ASCA Dog Bite Policy**. All UMASC investigations and appropriate forms will be forwarded on to the ASCA Business office. Dogs excused or disqualified under said policy will be excused from the remainder of the event and asked to leave, without refunds of entry fees.

DIRECTIONS:

From the South: Take I 35 to and through Duluth. I 35 freeway turns into residential Highway 61 (London Road) at 26th Ave. E. in Duluth. Stay in the right hand lane on I 35 as you reach the end of the freeway then follow highway 61 approximately 3 miles to 61st Ave. E., which occurs immediately after you cross over the Lester River Bridge. Turn left at 61st Av. E. Go two blocks to Superior St. Once you cross Superior Street 61st becomes the Lester River Rd. Follow the Lester River Road about 5 miles to the stop sign. Turn left on Strand Road and go 1 mile to stop sign. Turn left on N. Tischer Rd, go ¼ mile to Arrowhead Dog Training Academy- on your right.

From Grand Rapids, Bemidji, etc.: Take Hwy 2 to Hwy 194 to Midway Rd. (stop light) Turn left on Midway Rd. Continue across Hwy 53 at the stop light and go 1 mile to stop sign. Follow "Range Directions" below.

From Virginia/Ely/Cook: Take Hwy 53 south toward Duluth. Turn Left on Midway Road (stop light). Go approximately 1 mile to stop sign. Follow "Range Directions" below.

"Range Directions" Turn right (east) on Martin Road. Go until it ends on Jean Duluth Road - about 11 miles. Turn Left on Jean Duluth Road and go about 2 miles to W. Tischer Road (Billy's Bar on your left). Turn Right on W. Tischer - go 2 miles - road turns to the left and turns into N. Tischer Road. Go 1/4 mile on N. Tischer to Arrowhead Dog Training Academy - on your left.

From Wisconsin: North on Hwy 53 thru Superior then across the Blatnik bridge on into Duluth. Continue 1 mile past bridge on HWY 53 and veer right onto North-bound I-35/Hwy 61. Follow **From the South directions.**

From the North Shore: Go south on Hwy 61 from Two Harbors to 61st Ave. E. Duluth (immediately before the Lester River Bridge. Turn right (north) on 61st Ave. E. Follow **From the South Directions.**

ASCA MEMBERSHIP AND TRACKING NUMBER FORM

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here, "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, Inc., affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack thereof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release ASCA (including ASCA officers, directors, employees, and members), the Upper Midwest Australian Shepherd Club (including its officers, agents, and employees), and Arrowhead Dog Training Academy, Duluth, MN (including its officers, agents and employees), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Exhibitor/owner hereby assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
